

Umbwa Inaruka (Jumping Dog) Trophy was donated by Ricki Smith in 2001.

To win this trophy, you will need to get 3 qualifications in a jumping dog trial. If 2 dogs have the same number of qualifications, it will be awarded to the dog who beat the course times by the most.

This would be done by adding up the course times then subtracting the dogs qualifying times to ascertain who was the quickest e.g. course time is 35 seconds, the qualification score was 31 seconds, which means this was 4 seconds faster than the course time.

If no dog achieves 3 qualifications, then it would go to 2 then 1 qualification. If there were no qualifications then it would be awarded to the dog who had attempted a Jumping Dog Trial, but received a non-qualifying score.

The Umbwa Inaruka-Jumping Dog Trophy is a perpetual trophy and as such is presented at the AGM each year and held by the winner until required for the following year.

To be eligible for the Sangoma Perpetual Obedience Award, results must be submitted in writing by the dogs owner and addressed to the Secretary no later than 8th of January.

Results information should include: name of dog, name of owner, name of breeder (if known), officiating Clubs of trials, names of Judges, course times and times achieved at each trial.
