**Karnimirie Plate** was donated by Sharyn Hurley (nee Couchman) for completion at Esk Shire's three agricultural shows - Esk, Lowood and Laidley.

The trophy is presented to the dog gaining the highest aggregate points, with points awarded as per the Show Encouragement Award (Foxridge Trophy.)

The Karnimirie Cup is a perpetual trophy and as such is presented at the AGM each year and held by the winner until required by the following AGM.

To be eligible for the Karnimirie Cup, results must be submitted in writing by the dogs owner and addressed to the club marked "Attention Trophy Steward" and received no later than 8<sup>th</sup> of January.

Results information should include: name of dog, name of owner, name of Breeder, name of shows, names of judges, highest award at each show and number of points for which show award is eligible.

As at 18th February 2017 the Karnimirie Plate is to go to its original Shows of Esk, Laidley Toogoolawah and Lowood.
